## Case Examples

### *Damages for Sports Stars*

BTG Forensic personnel successfully calculated damages on behalf of two very high profile sports people, one a major track and field star and the other a major name in the world of snooker. Our calculations involved computations of a base loss to which were added a number of hypothetical scenarios at varying percentage chances. Both cases required a thorough understanding of the prize money system of each sport, sponsorship deals, invitational income, agents' fees and detailed costs incurred by professional sports people.

### *Employment Test*

Our personnel acted for the claimant in an employment test case. The claimant won his claim in the House of Lords for loss of earnings, benefits, bonuses, pension and the use of a residential property. The claim was based on six scenarios, and for over £2m. The case mirrors a personal injury claim in its detail and methodology.

### *Paraplegic Settlement*

BTG Forensic personnel acted on behalf of the UK's top fund manager at the time, who was left paralysed after a road traffic accident. Our financial evidence included complex bonus and share remuneration analysis. The case settled for a record sum in UK personal injury history.

### *Workplace Injury*

Our personnel acted for a young claimant seriously injured on an oil rig. The claim included putting together a comprehensive schedule of losses including all of the care costs, rehabilitation costs and loss of future earnings.

### *MoD Criminal Injuries and PTSD Litigation*
