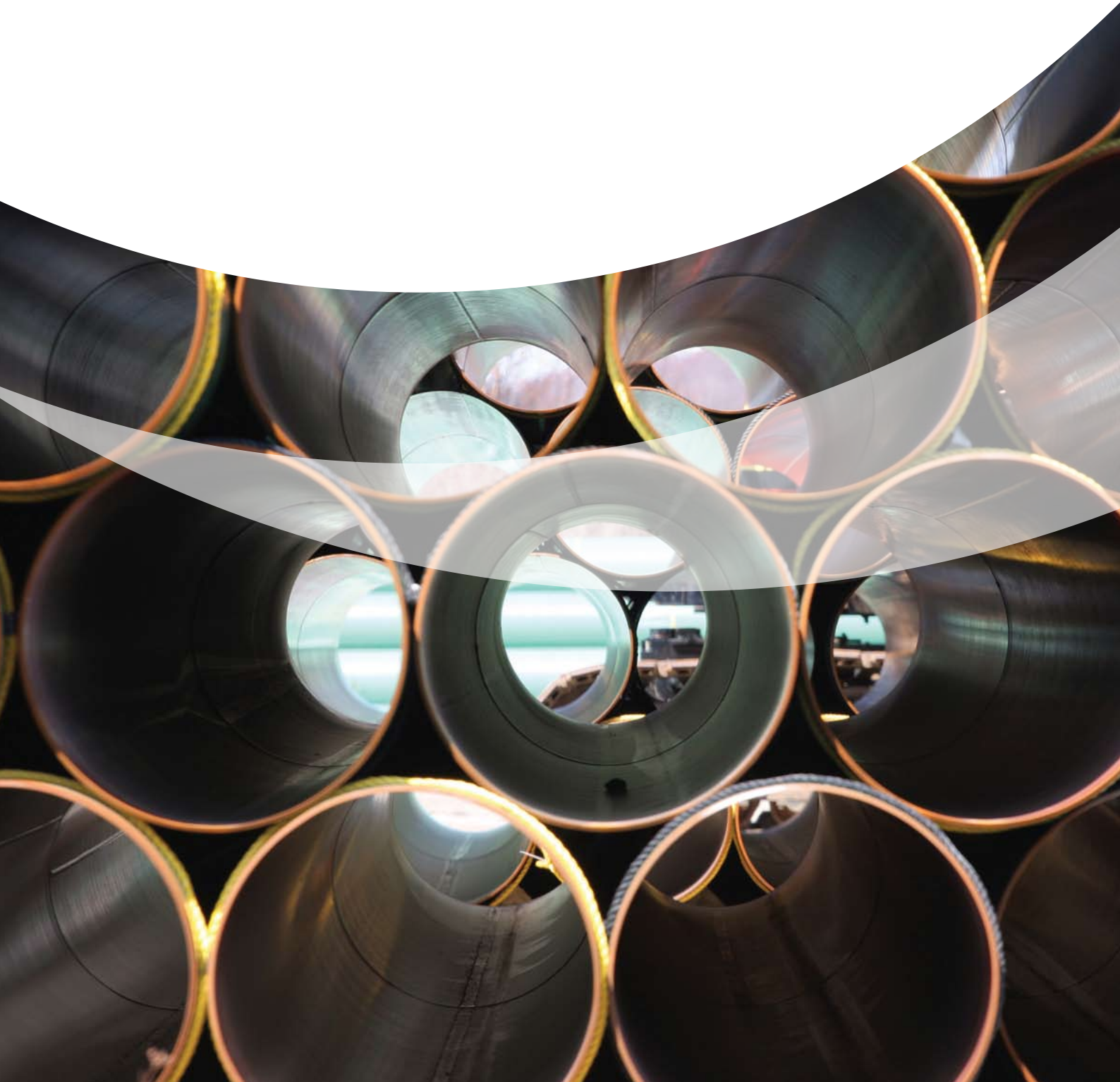

Case Examples

Militant Attacks

When an oil services vessel was hijacked by militants in a conflict zone we were notified immediately. The hijackers took expatriate crew members hostage in the jungle and made political and ransom demands. Within hours of the incident our response team was in situ with the victim company and also in forward areas of the country. We resolved the kidnapping successfully and promptly, ensuring the safe repatriation of victims and vessel.

Pipeline Security

A major utility constructing gas and water pipelines suffered a rise in vandalism and theft: resulting losses eroded profit margins for this self-insured project. Our environmental criminologists developed a bespoke risk assessment and security health check to identify and mitigate threats while controlling security costs. Launching a training and awareness programme, we also reviewed serious incidents, bolstered their existing security function and developed crisis plans to prepare for newly identified risks. As a result, the project reduced losses, increased efficiency and returned to profit.

Oil Transaction Fraud

A Middle East based petro-chemical business grew concerned with a €800m transaction. Our certified fraud examiners stress-tested elements of the transaction and found irregularities demanding further examination. We mounted a formal investigation and uncovered industrial espionage and physical intimidation involving personnel in positions of trust within the company. Further security breaches were identified and corrected and the transaction halted. Losses were recovered and controls improved.
