If you do not make payment, in full, within 7 days of the date of this letter I will instruct the Solicitor of HM Revenue & Customs to present a petition to wind up the company, without further warning, to the High Court, on the grounds that the company is unable to pay its debts.

You should be aware that once a petition is filed with the court, it must be advertised in the London/Belfast Gazette (as appropriate) not less than 7 business days after service on the company. This may cause the company's bank accounts to be frozen and enable any other creditors to support the petition.

- You should write the above reference directly after 'HM Revenue & Customs only'

No further warning will be given. If the company does not pay, the next action will be the filing of the petition.
